Ultra runners embrace McCall challenge

As Lorenn Walker, 71, neared the end of an arduous 50-mile trek while tackling the McCall Trail Running Classic Saturday near Burgdorf Hot Springs, she was confident it would be her one and only ultra-marathon.

A few days later, Walker said she feels great and is "so stoked she did it."

"I finished (the race) swearing I would never do it again," Walker said. "But now after recovering, I think I might have to try again and finish faster."
The 71-year-old, who spends time in both

McCall and on Oahu, Hawaii, was one of 100 entrants who took on distances of 30K (kilometer), 50K and 50 miles during the race's 10th year running.

No stranger to marathons during her younger years, Walker said Saturday's trek was the longest she has ever run at one time.

Walker said her running coach, Jeremy

Humphrey, suggested she tackle the longer to top the men. distance.
"The race course was well-marked and in

stunningly beautiful places, causing me to stop a few times to take photos," Walker said. The McCall runner competed despite a

sinus infection and antibiotics that left her less than 100 percent.

Walker said she also struggled the final six miles after miscalculating her hydration and nutrition needs. She drank water out of running streams to help her finish and come in before the required end time, 9:30 p.m., Saturday.

Walkerwas able to complete the up-anddown course in under 19 hours. Meanwhile, the first runner in during the women's 50-miler, Jenna Maffey, took it down in 12

hours, 18 minutes, 37 seconds. Vernon Hawks completed the course, which started and finished at Pete's Creek Trailhead just north of Burgdorf, in 12:36:39

Local runners fared well. McCall's Ruth Kennedy was fourth in for the women in the 50-miler while Samuel Thompson, also of

McCall, was seventh among the men's field.
McCall runner Jerrod Warner came in second during the men's 50Krun, while local Kay McGowan was fourth in the women's race. McCall runners turned in the top three times during the men's 30K, with Mac Keller setting the standard with a time of 2:48:53.

The McCall Trail Running Classic was first introduced in 2012 and held at Jug Mountain Ranch.

The event was moved to its new location for the 2023 race.

In finishing Saturday, Walker credited her running coach, Humphrey. She said knee exercises she learned from Cheyenne Pietri of Legend Crossfit in McCall also "enabled me to take up long distance trail running in my 60's.'
